

Training/Educational Source Credits (hours)

Note: Credits received in any given year in excess of the required 6 hours may be transferred into the subsequent year as credit. The maximum credit transferable to a subsequent year is limited to 4 hours.

Directors should tour/inspect their respective levee and its infrastructure annually.

Credit hours listed below are estimates only. Actual training/learning hours attributable to the event/exercise are what actual credits will be based on.
